

## God's Enduring Mercies

With God there are endless possibilities. There is an endless mercy, an endless grace, an endless forgiveness, and more. *"And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin..."* (Exodus 34:6-7). Here is where God defines Himself to Moses and what did He say? He said He is merciful, abundant in goodness, keeps mercy for thousands, and forgives them. What a God!

Jeremiah said, *"It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness"* (Lamentations 3:22-23). Even Jeremiah noted how God extends new mercies and compassions every day. God is always faithful to stand with us when we have failed and are yet to repent.

David sang, *"Oh give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; for his mercy endures forever!"* (Psalm 118:1). David knew that his life would be worthless without God's mercies and abundant goodness. When you really realize the abundance of God's goodness and mercies towards you, I believe that you will explode in praise because God accepts you for who you are, no matter what you have done. What a God!

Honestly God already knows you and your messes; He just wants you to come and trust Him to fix it. How many times has His mercies got you out of trouble? The God of endless impossibilities was there all along taking care of you. And because of your worth God had to shower His abundance of goodness and mercy over you!
