

Ever Mindful of You

King David once said to God, *“What is man, that you are mindful of him? And the son of man, that you should visit him?”* (Psalm 8:4). We often feel so insignificant that we think, *“Why would God want to be mindful of me or visit?”* but truthfully God does, and He is closer than you think. He sees you all the time and is ever mindful of you. Look at what God told Isaiah about you, *“Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? yea, they may forget, yet will not I forget you. Look, I have graven your name upon the palms of my hands...”* (Isaiah 49:15-16). You were so important to God that He engraved your name upon the palms of His hands. He sees your every movement, He watches over you, and He knows everything about you. He alone knows your bad days and good because He comes to visit you.

God loves to love you – even when you feel unlovable. He loves to send blessings to you – even when you feel like you don’t deserve it. He loves to show how much He cares for you – even when you don’t care too much about yourself. He is always planning good things for you. He is always looking forward to talking with you. He loves it when you pray because He loves to hear you call His name. So never think for a moment that you are forgotten, or your labor of love is unnoticed. When you are feeling unappreciated, never think that God doesn’t hear or see it all. Indeed, He hears every cry, sees every tear that falls, and He knows you better than you know yourself. And because He loves you, He gives every day as a present to you.

God is thinking about you ALL the time! One day David caught a glimpse of how often God thinks of him. Being overwhelmed he exclaimed, *“How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How great is the sum of them! If I should count them, they are more than the sand; when I awake, I am still with You.”* David understood that God was thinking about him day and night. Furthermore, look what God said to Jeremiah for you, *“For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith Jehovah, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you hope in your latter end* (Jeremiah 29:11). God is thinking all the time about how to give you a better end than your beginning. You cannot imagine how many times a day that God is thinking about you.

You may feel like your mess up is so bad that there is no way that God can fix it – but you must know that nothing is impossible with God. I saw some time ago that God was already in my future. He is not constrained by time since He created it, and therefore time must serve and obey His Master’s commands. This is how, God has the ability to go into your future. He has planned a great day for you and is excited to present it to you. Even if you say, *“Oh, there can only be bad days,”* that will not stop God from laying out your greater purpose!

So, awake each morning, ready to receive God’s good thoughts and great plans for you. If troubles come, don’t allow them to cause you fearfulness, anxiousness, or worry because that is Satan’s plan is to steal the joys of your day and your plans. Don’t accept his plans or packages, *they aren’t for you*. It doesn’t have your name on it, and you did not order it, so don’t accept it, or sign the ticket. Just say, *“Return to sender, I did not order this package. It is not for me. God only has good things for me, and I can only accept those packages.”*

Thank you for being ever mindful of them. I know that you have plans to prosper them so let them not be doubtful that you would bless them. May they not be worried or anxious when facing challenges because you are with them.
